## Falling Plates Specialty Match

## January 21, 2023 Plates Bay 8(pistol range)

The falling plates are a fun and challenging match for all shooting levels. This year I am going to try something new.

Divisions are as follows:

Centerfire Pistol. Any center fire pistol with a caliber smaller than .44 S&W. Revolver or semi auto. Any sighting system. NO rifle caliber 'Pistols'

Rimfire Pistol. Any pistol in .22LR caliber. Any sighting system.

Shooter will take all instructions and commands from the Range Safety Officer, e.g. make ready, shooter ready, stand by, reload for next string, unload and show clear. This is a cold range match; all firearms will be unloaded and moved on and off the course of fire in a strong side holster or a range bag. Pistols will be unloaded with slides/bolts locked open (revolver cylinders open) and muzzles pointed up (at least 45 degrees) and down range. All movement on and off the course and movement between the strings will be controlled by the Range Safety Officer. Any questions please email Corey Cruts at <u>tsgc.specialty@gmail.com</u>

Registration will open at 8:30, shooting starts at 10:00.

48 rounds per division.

Shooters may shoot in both Divisions

First division \$15.00, additional division \$10.00 for TSGC Members First division \$25.00, additional division \$20.00 for non-TSGC Members Starting position,

- Standing at the 10 yard line
- Pistol loaded with 6 rds
- Pistol at the low ready (Pistol down at 45 degrees to the ground)

At the start signal engage all six, 8 inch, falling plates with in the par-time of 6 seconds.

Reload with 6 rds, off the clock, and shoot the string again

Repeat this at all four distances, 10 yrds, 15 yrds, 20 yrds, and 25 yrds.

Each distance will be shot under a par-time (countdown clock)

**Pistol Divisions** 

- 10 yrds = 6 sec
- 15 yrds = 7 sec
- 20 yrds = 8 sec
- 25 yrds = 9 sec

## Scoring,

Scoring will be total number of plates knocked down for the shooters entire course of fire (48 total plates).

Tie breaker,

Tie breaker will be a single string shot from the 25 yrd line with a reduced partime (8 seconds) if the tie is not broken the 25 yrd string will be shot again reducing par-time until the tie is broken.
