

Tri-State Gun Club Range Diagram, 2019



Rifle Ranges - The General Purpose Ranges (25yd, 50yd, and 100yd) and the Law Enforcement Officer (LEO) Range may be shot with any rifle (up to .50 caliber), pistol, revolver, and any black powder rifle of any caliber.

- Law Enforcement Officer (LEO) Range: Firearms shooting buckshot or slugs are allowed on firing positions 11 and greater, Please use target backers that are in the worst condition for Shotgun/shot shell activities. As with all activities please police your spent ammunition and used targets
- Conduct rifle rapid fire within 15 yards of a bullet-stopping berm.
- A helicopter flight corridor (500ft AGL) runs east/west behind the rifle ranges. Hold your fire and point firearm muzzles downward until the helicopters have passed and are clear. Maintain situational awareness and be a responsible neighbor.

Shotgun Range - All shot shell guns of any caliber or configuration may be fired with bird shot only. NO centerfire or rimfire allowed UNLESS firing shot shells.

- Clays Range Briefing: Contact a BoD member or Officer for a detailed briefing on clays machine operations

Archery ranges - No broad-heads or crossbows allowed.

- Zero/practice lane behind the Clubhouse marked with distances out to 80 yards.
- The 3D archery range is a 15-target walking trail that is available for general Club member and accompanied guest use. No preset distances on the 3D range, group choice.
- Please limit use to 2 arrows per target per round.

Primitive Arms Range

- Firearms allowed: Traditional muzzle loaders or pellet guns. In line muzzle loaders must be fired on the multipurpose ranges.
- When shooting muzzleloaders on the primitive range ensure trail markers are set out. Trail markers not required for pellet guns.

Pistol Ranges - Pistols, revolvers, and rimfire rifles are authorized for use in the pistol bays. Pistol caliber carbines in the following calibers are permitted in the pistol bays: 9mm, .45 ACP, .45 Colt, .357 Mag, .38, .44 Special (NOT Magnum), .40 S&W, .380, 10mm (ball ammo only), and all traditional Cowboy loads. Centerfire rifles/carbines in any other caliber are NOT permitted.

- Steel targets are not permitted in the Bulls-Eye Bay (Bay 1) to prevent splatter from spilling over to CR 437.
- No shot shell or centerfire rifle ammunition may be used on the pistol ranges.
- Lead core, solid lead, coated lead, or frangible bullets only. No steel core, tungsten core, solid copper, solid brass, or solid gilding metal bullets are permitted.
- Shoot no closer than 10 yards from the steel. (Marked by 10 yard line signs.)
- No guns/ammunition with a power factor greater than .357 Magnum/.45 automatic.
- 44 Magnum, 50AE, 454 Casull, 500 S&W are not allowed on steel.
